TASKS & TECHNICAL INFORMATION

The bulk of what we're looking for falls into a handful of buckets. Tasks will be determined by available skill-sets and talents of those that show up.

- Optimizing and slicing the new designs' PSDs
- Creating the HTML/CSS templates
- Back-end improvements and new features – we currently use:
 - PHP
 - CodeIgniter MVC framework (no experience necessary)
 - light amounts of Javascript
- Database improvements (MySQL)
- Android and iOS prototyping (either native or cross-platform)
- Strategy, user experience, and big-picture thinking
